Frequently asked questions

Do golf coaches or schools market each prospective student-athlete to college coaches?

No, per NCAA bylaws golf coaches/schools are not allowed to market or “sell” students to college golf coaches. However, they are allowed to consult with a student about each step in their recruiting process and serve as a reference to their academics, character and golf abilities.

What is the NCAA?

The NCAA or National Collegiate Athletic Association is a governing body for collegiate sports. They regulate and enforce rules concerning eligibility across college sports for schools that participate in NCAA Division I, II or III athletics.

Which college entrance exam (SAT or ACT) is best for me?

Generally, the decision is up to the student as to which test they feel most comfortable with. The SAT is concentrated around English even throughout the math portion. The ACT includes word problems but overall is more math oriented with some science. A growing, yet still small list of colleges, are not requiring SAT or ACT scores for admission.

Do I need to take the TOEFL (Test of English as Foreign Language) test?

If you have attended a school using an English based curriculum or school in the United States for the past four years, the TOEFL requirement is usually waived. If you are entering college from a non-English based curriculum it is required for admission. Colleges generally require between 61 and 100 on the Internet Based Test for admission.

What do college coaches look for in a student-athlete?

Coaches are always looking for motivated student-athletes who perform well in the classroom and on the golf course. You should maintain the highest GPA and college entrance exam test scores possible. They want a student-athlete who brings a good attitude to the team, is easily coachable and has high expectations of themselves.
